

IRON is drawn from a metalworking atelier in Geneva, Switzerland – a place where metal is bent into public structures, private spaces, contemporary artworks, and restorations of cultural heritage.

The collection spans 25 archives with 1,944 unique metallic object sounds. It captures the full sonic life of the metallurgy atelier: sparks, welding, machines in motion, the clash of tools, metallic percussions on sculptures and structures, resonant cubes, spheres and shafts, fractured plates, gears, anvils, and incidental noises. Four microphone positions (XY, ORTF, contact, shotgun) were used depending on the source, shaping a raw and diverse vocabulary of industrial sound.

The recordings are left untouched – raw matter, unprocessed. The artist holds full agency: to transform, to distort, or to let the weight of the workshop stand as it is.
